

Questions to Ask Employer During Interview

Choose two or three questions to ask the employer at the end of the interview which have not already been discussed.

- 1. How would you describe a typical workday?
- 2. What kind of training or orientation will be available?
- 3. Who would be my supervisor?
- 4. What do you think are the most important qualities for someone to excel in this role?
- 5. What do you hope I will accomplish in this position?
- 6. What would be the top 3 goals/projects during my first few weeks?
- 7. What are the greatest challenges for this position?
- 8. When and how often would I receive feedback regarding my job performance?
- 9. Please discuss the opportunities for advancement within the company.
- 10. How would you describe the work environment here?
- 11. What improvements or changes do you hope that a new candidate will bring to this position?
- 12. Does your company provide support to employees to further their education and/or training?
- 13. What do you like best about your job/company?
- 14. Where do you think the company is headed in the next 5 years?
- 15. When may I expect to hear back from you regarding the status of this position?
